TIME TO BE HEARD

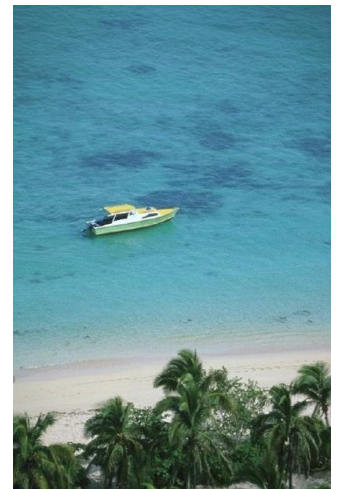
You would have to live under a rock in the Simpson Desert not to know that there is a Federal election on the 21st August.

This election, more than any other, we as responsible users of the environment need to have our voice heard. Our issues have now gone a lot further than fishing or access to National parks, access for caravans and campers or trail bike or horse riders, this is now about your civil rights, as Australians to responsibly enjoy what this great country has to offer and what generations of Australians have fought for in the past. Why should we be forced to eat imported seafood?

Your party will be taking these issues in to the political arena by running two candidates for the Senate in Queensland and possibly two in New South Wales.
